
For professional paper, header should include both a running head, an all caps abbreviated version of the title, as well as the page number.

Lighten the Mood: Long Term Effects of Radiation Exposure on Emotional Control

As with student papers, professional titles should be 3-4 spaces down, followed by a space followed by the author names and institution. If authors are part of different institutions, the affiliations are noted and listed as seen here.

Include another 3-4 spaces between the byline and the author note.

Professional papers include an author note, which consist in paragraphs of:

- 1: the OrcidID of the authors;
- 2: any in accessibility of the authors (changes institution, death) after publication;
- 3: disclosures, including conflicts of interest and acknowledgements of support;
- 4: preferred contact for the authors.

Exclude any paragraph that is does not apply (lack of OrcidID, lack of contact changes).
